What is Makaton? - About Makaton

Makaton is a unique language programme that uses symbols, signs and speech to enable people to communicate. It supports the development of essential communication skills such as attention and listening, comprehension, memory, recall and organisation of language and expression.

If you are a parent or carer of a younger child, I'm sure you'll have seen Makaton used in the popular children's TV series 'Mr Tumble'. Makaton supports communication for children with additional needs, including those who are hard of hearing, but with good SEND practice it has benefits for all children!

Each week the four signs we have learnt in the past week will be on the newsletter so you can practise at home too!
