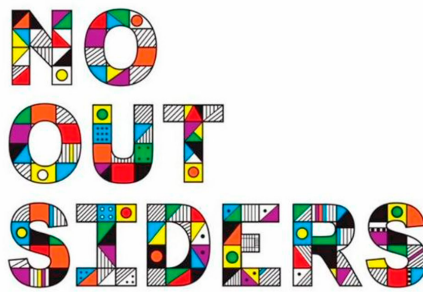

Makaton

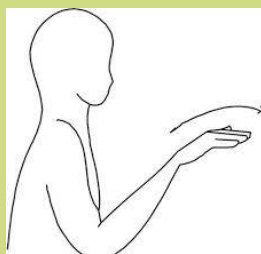

Each week, we will be learning four new words. Please see below this weeks words to practise at home.

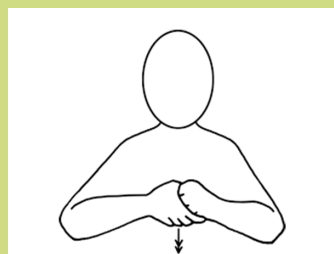
