Thank you to the families that attended the SEND Coffee morning on Monday. We thought about this academic year and considered what has gone well, possible changes and next steps. Below are some of the key discussion points:

- SEND Coffee mornings work well. Next year we want to continue to have outside agencies be part of them but also want to invite secondary SENCOs in to explain what SEND provision is like at their schools.
- Next, we would like to invite children with additional needs to develop their own group, to discuss their experiences and help shape school life.
- Parents would like more time to discuss additional needs with class teachers.

All feedback will be included in our updated Information Report and policy in September. All feedback is also considered as part of our in-school action planning. For example, last year families requested regular information regarding SEND on newsletters...and Inclusion Corner has been on them weekly ever since!
