## Composer of the week Anoushka Shankar (1981-):

Anoushka Hemangini Shankar is a British-American sitar player and musician of Indian heritage. She was born in London and spent her childhood between London and Delhi. The daughter of Sukanya Rajan and renowned sitar maestro Ravi Shankar, she is also the half-sister of singer Norah Jones and Shubhendra "Shubho" Shankar. In her teenage years, she lived in Encinitas, California, where she attended San Dieguito High School Academy, graduating with honours in 1999 before choosing to pursue music rather than university.

Shankar performs across a wide range of styles, including classical Indian, contemporary, acoustic, and electronic music, and has released seven solo albums since her debut in 1998. She has collaborated with many artists, including Karsh Kale and her father Ravi Shankar. Over her career, she has received fourteen Grammy Award nominations and became the first musician of Indian origin to both perform live and present at the Grammy Awards.

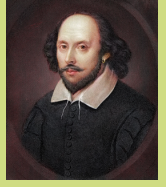
