Transitional objects are things that we can touch and hold on to that can help us feel safe or give us comfort. If a child is regularly anxious or upset about leaving their parent or caregiver, we may suggest the use of a transition object to support them from being dependent to independent; to support them to 'feel' that their loved one is with them throughout the day. Transition objects should fit into a pocket so that they can be squeezed or small enough to store in a bag/locker if less needed once in school. Ideas include: a folded-up letter, a photo, a miniature toy of significance. Transition objects are a part of our provision, so it is really important that any objects have been agreed with a member of Senior leadership team as part of a wider plan to ensure they are successful.
