Internet Safety

Children tend to more time on their mobile phones or on the internet over the holidays than they do during a school week. After holidays, many primary and secondary schools across the country unfortunately often end up becoming involved in incidents that have occurred on social media apps between pupils.

Please note that none of our pupils meet the age restrictions for the social media apps identified right. There is a reason why these age limits exist. Although children are often very technically savvy, they do not yet possess the emotional maturity to use these platforms safely and courteously. The use of these can lead to disagreements between pupils, the use of inappropriate language, cyberbullying and pupils being exposed to explicit content.

What are the age restrictions on social media?

If you choose to let your children use these apps, please can we remind parents/carers to be especially vigilant over this period and to regular monitor their children's use of the internet/social media apps. It is also important to talk to children about what to do if they become worried about something they see online. Thank you for your support with this.

Year 5 and 6 Basketball Competition



The composer this week is Toumani Diabaté (too-MAH-nee jah-BAH-tay):

This is one of Mr Millington's absolute favourites.


Toumani Diabaté (10/8/1965-19/7/2024) was a Malian kora player. In addition to performing the traditional music of Mali, he was involved in cross-cultural collaborations with flamenco, blues, jazz, and other international styles of music. In 2006, the London-based newspaper The Independent named him one of the fifty best African artists.

The kora is a stringed instrument used extensively in West Africa. A kora typically has 21 strings, which are played by plucking with the fingers. It combines features of the lute and harp
