Please see information regarding the UK's emergency alert service below:

A nationwide test of the UK's emergency alert service will take place at 3pm on Sunday 7 September 2025.

The alerts will warn you if there's a danger to life nearby, such as flooding or fires.

However, we are concerned about the potential safety risks to survivors who may be keeping their phones hidden from an abuser, as the alert is a loud, siren-like sound with a screen message and vibration.

Survivors can opt out from receiving emergency alerts to avoid their device from being detected.

Emergency Alerts will be sent to compatible mobile phones within an area of risk. Emergency alerts work on:

- iPhones running iOS 14.5 or later
- Android phones and tablets running Android 11 or later

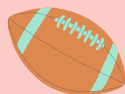
The alert may still be received on earlier versions of Android. To check, search your device settings for 'emergency alerts'.

Composer of the week

Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750):



Johann Sebastian Bach was born in Germany, where his father was a town musician. Bach came from a long line of composers – over 300 years' worth of Bachs all worked as professional musicians.

During his lifetime, people thought of Bach as just an ordinary working musician. No one really knew much about his music until 100 years after his death, when another composer, Felix Mendelssohn, conducted a performance of Bach's St. Matthew Passion.

Bach is now seen as one of the greatest geniuses in music history.
