

Inclusion Corner Transitional Objects

Transitional objects are things that we can touch and hold on to that can help us feel safe or give us comfort.

If a child is regularly anxious or upset about leaving their parent or caregiver, we may suggest the use of a transition object to support them from being dependent to independent; to support them to 'feel' that their loved one is with them throughout the day.

Transition objects should fit into a pocket so that they can be squeezed or small enough to store in a bag/locker if less needed, once in school. Ideas include:

- a folded up letter
- a photo
- a miniature toy of significance

Please ensure the use of a transition object has been agreed with a member of SLT and that your child knows they are responsible for keeping the item safe. Larger teddies and multiple keyrings are not appropriate.
