We started by finding out about the different types of homes we live in. We then thought about things we may see in our local area and learned about human and physical features. We created a map to show what we could see on our journey to school.



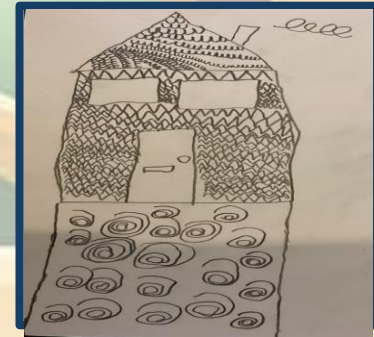
In our Art lessons we created our own artwork in the style of Fiona Willis. In DT we have been learning how to weave.

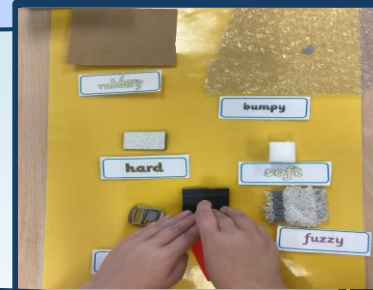
RE and Science

In RE, we have been learning about Christianity.

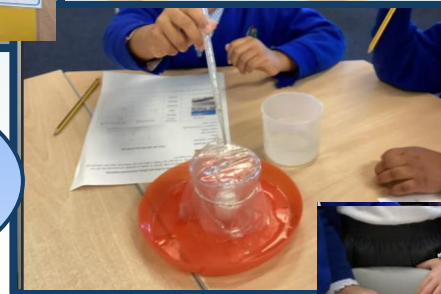
In science we have been learning about materials and their properties.

How do Christians celebrate Christmas?

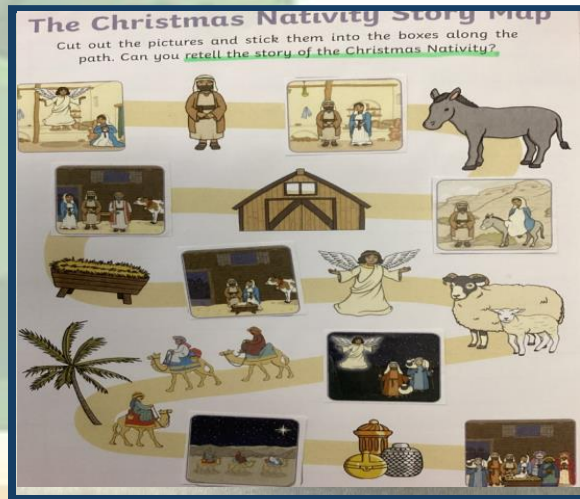


Christians celebrate a christmas tree with a star on top.

We have used number lines, tens frames, part whole models, cubes and counters to support our learning.

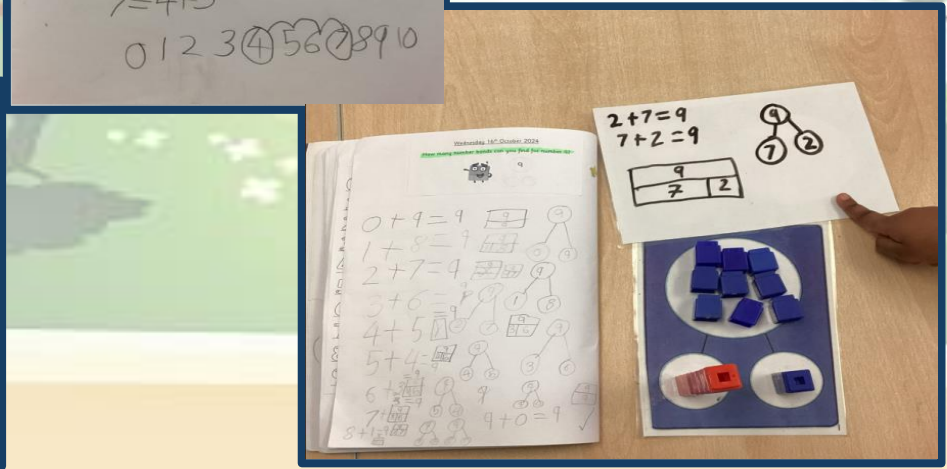
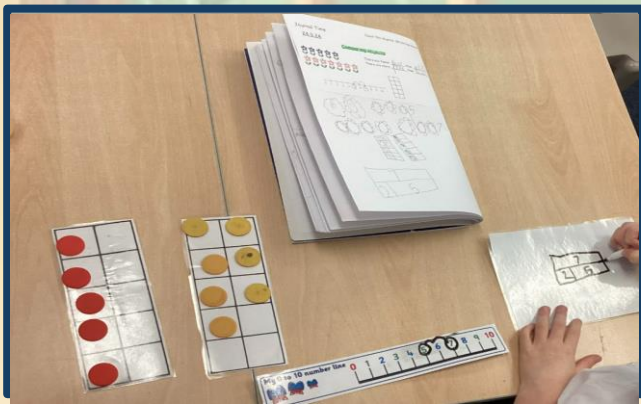
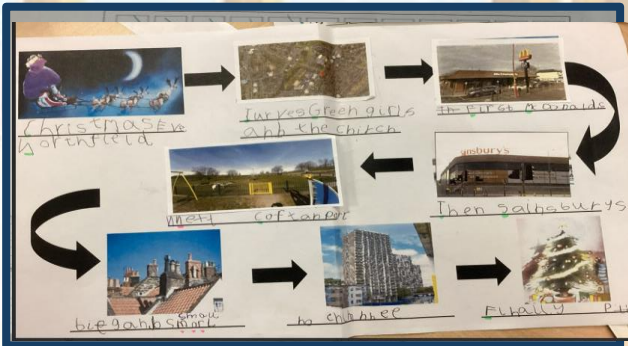
