













We found out that the death of Edward the Confessor led to a battle for the English throne.


The main contenders were Harald Hardrada, Harold Godwinson and William of Normandy.

However, we soon discovered there were some ingenious ways to attack the castles.






Instantity the bird plew to a young boy who stood infant of them grasping a lawerdar cropon...
