Coffee Afternoon - drop in sessions with our school EP and CAT teacher On May 13th between 2pm and 3pm we will be hosting a Coffee Afternoon with a difference. Instead of having a visiting expert speaking to us about a given topic, you will be able to ask a question about a Special Educational Need pertinant to your child.

Dr Annie Kent (our school Educational Psychologist) will be available to answer questions around topics such as emotional regulation, mental well being, behaviour, anxiety etc.

Matt Blackburn (Communication and Autism Team Specialist Teacher) will be available to answer questions around supporting and identifying sensory differences, strategies for better sleep, strategies to support personal care or self-care routines, playing and intering with children in a different way, social communication needs etc.


